welcome to Lawaki Beach House on Beqa Island!

We would like to introduce ourselves: Lawaki Beach House on Beqa is a small eco-tourism enterprise. The owners, Sam Tawake from Beqa and Christine Tawake-Bachofner from Switzerland have built it and are managing the business since its opening in 2003.

Our accommodation consists of 5 Bure and a total of 18 beds.

Our staff come from the nearby villages Naiseuseu and Naceva.

Our electricity is generated by a solar system and a backup generator.

Our water comes from a spring up on 100mt on the hill.

Our food grows in Fiji, mainly in our own garden or on Viti Levu.

Our main activity is snorkeling the house reef which is a non-fishing area since 2004.

Our guests are all age groups, singles, couples and families from all over the world as well as locals from Fiji.

Our MPA (Marine Protected Area) is our passion. We try to keep the impact to the coral reef low wherever we can.

We are engaged with a school project in Naceva where we help organizing food for 3 lunches per week for 80 children. (www.loloma.ch). School visits can be arranged on Tuesday and Thursday.

FOR THE YACHT GUESTS:

YOU ARE WELCOME TO ANCHOR AT LAWAKI. WE ASK YOU TO PLEASE RESPECT THE FOLLOWING:

THERE IS NO FISHING.

THERE IS A SPECIAL PASSAGE TO COME A SHORE. A small white pole marks the entrance point (note, this is not a channel, care is needed at low tide). Enter opposite the pole, on a 90 degree heading to shore. You may drop anchor between the pole and the shore, where the sea bed is sand and seagrass, but please not further out on the coral reef top.

If you wish to do a Sevusevu to a village please go to Naiseuseu in Waqa Bay or ask Sam in Lawaki.

Our House guests and daytrip guests contribute F\$ 12.00 towards the MPA. This is to encourage the Qoliqoli owners (villages with the traditional fishing right) and say "Vinaka" for not fishing. (We handle the cash for them and pay end of the year.)

Our restaurant offers lunch, dinner, tea, coffee, homemade cakes.

LUNCHES are available from F\$ 7.00-26.00.

DINNER 3 course cost F\$ 35.00 / 24.00 for children from 4-14 y/old. FREE for children up to 4 y/o with their parents.

Please book in advance and let us know if you require special diets.

Please note we don't have a liquor license and therefore ask you to bring your own alcohol.

We look forward to meet you soon! Till then: we wish you safe travel.
